Structuring rough drafts with AI

Overview

This module is a short interactive resource exploring how AI can help shape rough drafts into usable material.

The focus is on the early stage of content development, where material is often loosely organised and difficult to work with. AI is used to support the identification of structure rather than the generation of finished content.

Structure and interaction

The module follows a linear sequence with a small number of interactions:

- An initial prompt invites reflection on how to approach a rough draft before introducing any guidance.
- A short scenario describes the problem in context.
- Key principles are presented using an accordion, allowing content to be revealed progressively.
- A video demonstrates one possible approach using AI to generate an initial structure.
- A short knowledge check reinforces key ideas.

Interaction is limited and purposeful. Each element supports a single step in the process, avoiding unnecessary complexity.

Visual design

The layout is simple and consistent with minimal visual styling. Spacing is used to separate sections and create a clear reading flow.

A single accent colour is applied across interactive elements to maintain consistency within the constraints of Rise. Typography remains neutral and unobtrusive to keep attention on content.

Visual hierarchy is created through scale and spacing rather than decoration.

Accessibility

Content is ordered in a clear linear sequence, supporting both scrolling and sequential reading.

Accordion content allows learners to control how much information is revealed at once. The transcript provides a text alternative to the video.

Interactive elements are simple and predictable, reducing cognitive load.

Constraints

The module was developed within Rise, which limits control over:

- layout and theme
- typography within interaction blocks
- colour application across components.

Design decisions prioritise clarity and usability within these constraints rather than attempting to override them.

Summary

This module uses:

- focused structure
- minimal, purposeful interaction
- reflection to prompt engagement
- a short video demonstrating one possible approach.

It is designed as a practical resource focused on structuring early-stage content.
